Member Tips and Recommendations

Sent in by **Judi Roach**: In your stalls, if you'll put down a pelleted bedding (activating it by wetting it down) and then put a layer of shavings on top, the pellets will absorb all the urine and you'll be able to just scoop the poop, push aside the shavings and scoop the wet pellets. By doing this I haven't needed to strip a single stall!
